Benefit Plan Update

2016 was another milestone year for both the UGSOA medical and 401(k) plans. Participation was up for both plans and, as a result, we were given rate reductions for the 2017 plan year. We expect 2017 to again be a record year for the benefit plans and we are excited to announce several changes planned for this year.

UGSOA will be switching to a new National Medical Provider option (looking at June/July timeframe); including a new Medical option as well as a full offering of Supplemental benefits (STD, LTD, AD&D) for all members. Along with these newly anticipated benefit offerings, BSI will be launching a new web site called SCA View, where you will be able to log in and see exactly how your Health & Welfare funds are being applied. This site will be updated monthly so that you can track everything to the penny. Along with this information, you will be able to view benefits offered, 401(k) investment options and anything else related to your Health & Welfare funds.

BSI and UGSOA are growing because of you, our valued members, and we always want to ensure we are exceeding your expectations and getting you the best value possible!
